Please review the road sections available and choose one or more. When you sign up, you will be asked to note landmarks at the beginning and end of the section you are claiming, e.g. "Rt. 5 from the Norwich border to Pavilion Rd."

Please do both sides of the road section you claim. Consider signing up with a Green Up Day Buddy, since it is more fun to do with a friend, socially distanced of course.

Where to get Green Up Day bags: Special Green Up Day bags will be available to pick up outside the town office or at the transfer station. Look for them in 5-gallon plastic containers. You are also welcome to use your own bag, if that is more convenient.

Where to dispose of your Green Up Day bags: The Green Up Day collection will happen from 9 am-1 pm on Saturday, May 1st at the Dumpster across from the Town Hall. You can actually do your road clean-up at any time; just bring your bag for disposal on May 1.

Bonus! We will also be accepting bagged garlic mustard plants at the dumpster on Green Up Day.
