In accordance with 1 V.S.A. §314(b)(1), this is written notice of the following Open Meeting Law violation:

A majority of the Selectboard convened a meeting and conducted Town business in violation of S.222 (a)(3), which reads: "the members and staff of the public body shall not be required to be physically present at a designated meeting location."

The meeting was convened on February 7th, 2022 at 7:07pm at Thetford Town Hall and did not accommodate non-physical access, which therefore required participants (including myself, a member of the Thetford Selectboard) to be physically present at the designated meeting location in violation of S.222. The opening paragraph of S.222 reads:

It is the intent of the General Assembly that during the continued spread of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) in the State of Vermont, public bodies should organize and hold open meetings in a manner that will protect the health and welfare of the public while providing access to the operations of government.

The majority of the Selectboard was presented with S.222 before the meeting was convened. In fact, I presented that I had a high-risk family member and was not comfortable with the risk associated with in-person meetings. Steve Tofel responded, "You are not required to be here. You can leave." The Chair then convened the meeting. This represents wrongful exclusion under Vermont's Open Meeting law and S.222.

Four Selectboard members suggested over email earlier in the day that the meeting should be rescheduled with a Zoom link. The Chair ignored these comments and instead demanded that the meeting take place. Multiple residents emailed the Selectboard with concerns:

Melissa Krzal: "Went to attend the "public meeting" on zoom and surpise no zoom link. No notice. Is the meeting still legal?"

Susan Ricker: "Can you put the link to the Selectboard meeting on the Calendar on the Town's website for tonight's meeting, please? It isn't listed there.... Glad that you aren't that busy [Sharon], but I was under the impression that since you are allowed to have virtual meetings, that the public would be included in all meetings at this time."

Max Horster: "I attempted to join the selectboard meeting this evening and zoom said it was waiting for the host to open the meeting. The meeting never opened. I've spent 40 minutes waiting with nothing. If zooms are no longer taking place then I advise taking the link down from the website. If they are then the zoom link needs to be operable and the selectmen need to stream the meeting for the public to view. Advising that you can view it on zoom and then not start the meeting is unacceptable. Thank you for looking into this."

The Selectboard Assistant and Town Clerk highlighted these resident concerns to the Selectboard before the meeting was convened, however the feedback was ignored.

As a result of the Selectboard's willful actions, I was denied access to the meeting.

1 V.S.A. §314(b)(1) requires this written notice "requests a specific cure" of the alleged violations and that if it is found that a violation did occur, actions are taken to prevent future such violations. Because this violation represents a pattern of behavior from certain Selectboard members and the Chair spanning over a year and targeted primarily at me, I request that all actions and discussions that took place at the February 7th meeting be ruled invalid, that the offending Selectboard members issue a public apology for consciously and willingly excluding me, and that Sharon Harkay be removed as Chair on grounds of continued disregard for Open Meeting Law and abuse of power.

Failure by the Selectboard to respond to this notice within 10 calendar days shall be treated as a denial of the violation and may be appealed to the Organs County Superior Court.

Please note that this complaint is a Public Record.

12 13	Nick Clark believed the meeting was not legal because according to S.222, members of the public and the board shall not be required to be physically present at the meeting. Nick said he
13 14	has immunocompromised people to consider and did not feel comfortable being at the meeting in
15	person. He wanted to board to reschedule the meeting and offer virtual attendance in accordance
16	with S.222.
17	Martie Betts said the meetings should be consistent, as for two years a virtual option had been
18	offered, and some residents have been asking why they can't get into the meeting.

20	Sharon Harkay called the meeting to order at 7:07 PM.
21	
22	1. Agenda Review
23	Sharon reminded the Selectboard that at the last meeting they decided to continue to meet in
24	person, and the new Selectboard can decide how they want to attend their meetings going
25	forward. The decision to not offer a virtual option was for this meeting only, because most of the
26	meeting will be in executive session.
27	Tracy Borst said the law doesn't say the virtual option is dependent on the agenda. If the meeting
28	is expected to be mostly in executive session they can open the meeting, do whatever business
29 20	they do have and then close the discussion to the public. Steve Tofel felt they were all in the meeting and should continue with the discussion. If the
30 31	meeting turns out to be in violation, they can redo all of their decisions at the next meeting. He
32	questioned the wording of S.222 and said if Nick isn't required to be at the meeting in person, he
33	could leave.
34	The Selectboard discussed other dates.
35	After discussing, it was decided to continue with the meeting as warned. Nick Clark left the
36	meeting at 7:13 PM.
