## Drinking Water Study Purpose

This project will create a plan to bring the drinking water infrastructure within Thetford's 5 villages into the 21<sup>st</sup> century. Its goal is to address long-term drinking water needs for existing residential and businesses users while exploring future needs for housing & economic development, and fire protection. This document would also serve as source document for future federal and state funding for capital improvements.

  - Do you regularly test your water?
  - Do you have any other issues (please specify)?
- 3. Will it continue to be satisfactory for the next 20-50 years?
  - Is it close to a septic system or other potential contamination?
  - For private on-lot wells:
    - o if it failed, could you replace it?
    - o does it limit the resale value of your property?
    - o If you wanted to subdivide, could you obtain requisite water supply?
  - Do you think fire hydrants are important?
  - Would you pay more for a municipal operated water supply & distribution system?
