**Reference: Latham Road Phase 2 Roadway Rehabilitation and Phase 1 Completion**

Stantec has reviewed the three (3) bids received by the Town of Thetford for the referenced project at the bid opening on Wednesday, June 1, 2022, at 10:00 AM. Bids included a low bid of \$1,416,136.90 to a high bid of \$1,923,514.00 (including Base Bid and Bid Add Alternate #A). The following is a summary of the received bids:

The low bidder is Northwoods Excavating Inc. (Northwoods) of Thetford, VT with a total submitted bid price of \$1,416,136.90 which includes the Base Bid Total, and Bid Add Alternate#A. The complete bid tab summary is attached to this memorandum as Attachment A. Northwoods's complete bid and bid bond are also attached as Attachment C.

A summary of the Total Base Bid and Bid Add Alt total prices that were received from the three bidders for the project are summarized below.

The following sections summarize Stantec's bid review:

### **Contractor Qualification**

Northwoods successfully completed the following projects in Thetford, VT within the past five (5) years while serving as the general contractor on the project. These projects were all designed by Stantec; with construction for these projects also administered and inspected by Stantec, except for the Rte. 132 Phase 1 Roadway Reconstruction Project.

1. VT Rte. 132 Phase 2 Roadway Reconstruction (ongoing)
2. VT Rte. 132 Phase 1 Roadway Reconstruction
3. Turnpike Road South Roadway Repair and Culvert Installation
4. VT Rte. 132 Storm Damage Repairs Site# 12, 16 and 17
5. FEMA Storm Damage Repairs for Gove Hill Road
6. FEMA Storm Damage Repairs for Tucker Hill Road
7. Thetford Pedestrian Improvements Project

Stantec's overall experience with Northwoods is that they complete projects on time and within budget and perform quality work.

Based on our experience working with Northwoods for the above-mentioned projects, Northwoods's performance on these have been good on the noted projects that they have been involved with. All references indicated that they would hire Northwoods again for future work. The complete reference check forms are enclosed as Attachment B.

### **Bid Items Review**

Stantec reviewed Northwoods's bid unit item prices relative to Stantec's opinion of probable construction costs and did not identify unit item prices that were either considerably lower or considerably higher than Stantec's opinion of probable costs. This is an indication that Northwoods submitted a balanced bid.

### **Recommendation**

Based on review of the bid, Stantec's experience working with Northwoods, and the references contacted for this project, Northwoods is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Latham Road Phase 2 Roadway Rehabilitation Project in Thetford, VT. Stantec recommends that the Town of Thetford award the contract for the VT Rte. 132 Phase 2 Roadway Reconstruction Project to Northwoods Excavating, Inc.

**Reference: Latham Road Phase 2 Roadway Rehabilitation and Phase 1 Completion**

The bid for this project was structured to allow the Town some additional financial flexibility within the scope of the project. The bid included an Owners Bid Add Alternate item to repair and pave the limits of Phase 1 of the roadway. The intent of utilizing the Owners Add Alternate is award this portion of the project with the Base Bid - Phase 2 Road Rehabilitation scope of work, if the Town's available funds allow. It should be noted that Northwoods submitted the highest Owners Add Alternate price total with their bid the difference between their submitted bid and the low bid submitted by L&M was only roughly \$12,000 (3-percent higher). Considering the overall Base bid price plus the Owner's Add Alternate, Northwood's remains the low bidder.

Stantec recommends the award of the Contract to Northwoods Excavating Inc. for either the Base Bid or the Base Bid plus the Bid Add Alternate total, depending on the Town's available funds. We have provided a Notice of Award for Both of these options for the Town's used in Appendix D.

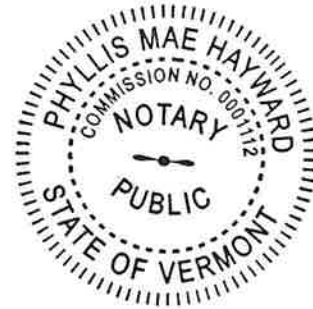
