What Is a Community Solar Agreement?

A Community Solar Agreement (CSA), also known as a Net Metering Agreement, is arrangement where a solar company, such as Norwich Solar, builds a solar project and offers the solar credits for sale to local customers. The solar company owns and operates the solar project, while the customer buys solar credits from the project and receives a discount on their electric bill. The discount on this Array is 7%. Income qualified residents may be eligible for greater discounts.

Benefits of a Community Solar Agreement

- Electricity cost reductions that are stable and predictable
- No upfront capital investment or maintenance/operating expenses
- Directly supports the deployment of new renewables on the grid
