Board Business

a) Agenda Review/Approval- None.

b) Approve Minutes

d) Correspondence-

- Alex Mathis and Kathy Hollander sent emails related to the potential reduction of the TES art position to 80%.
- Parent talked with Cook regarding the process for deciding on schoo delays-Gawel explained that he contacts the town road crews from several towns, looks at and listens to the weather, and bases his decisions on those factors.
- A parent communicated concern regarding transitions from TES to TA- how are the kids prepared for the increase in homework? Mills explained that there is communication between the teachers at both schools. The students visit as groups, and there are 1:1 visits if needed.
- A parent asked if there is a way that parents can be alerted on days that TA either doesn't have school or has an early release. It means there is a 10 minute difference in the bus run. Reigler also brought up having TES and TA schedules more aligned would make it easier for parents.

Solar Array Information: Nolan Reigler

The Certificate to expand our current array under the management of Norwhich Solar has been

approved by the state. It was hoped that it would be considered an expansion, but they approved it as a new array. It should provide a 7% discount over standard electric rates. Reigler has more questions for Norwich. Under the new lease, Norwich will be doing all the maintenance work on the array. There is more information needed from TES about the current power usage in order to know how well the planned changes will support all user needs, including TES; Nolan will contact the office to get this information. Further discussion ensued.

The final tuition rate was set: a 6.5% increase in tuition totaling \$23,890.00 per pupil
