

# Thetford Transfer Station

## What is the Update?

- As of Friday, March 1<sup>st</sup>, Thetford Transfer Station has received the recertification permit from the State of Vermont.
- This permit is good for 10 years.
- The permit, facility management plan and closure plan documents are on the Town website (under Transfer Station) and hard copies in a notebook at the Transfer Station.

## What Does This Mean for You as a Customer?

- Trash and food scrap disposal will be available as usual.
- Recycling bins for:
  - mix paper
  - cardboard
  - plastic
  - clean glass, ceramics, & window glass
  - scrap metal
  - aluminum cans
- Our additional recycling/reuse of materials will resume for:
  - Fluorescent bulbs
  - Batteries (primary/single-use, rechargeable (Ni-MH, NI-Cd, small sealed lead-acid, Lithium-ion and button type), cell phones, vape pens, and vehicle/marine lead-acid.
  - Books at shed
  - Clothing/shoes/accessories/Textile at bins
  - Clean plastic wrap/bags/bubble wrap for TREX program
  - Clean paper/plastic bags for food shelves
  - Corks
  - 4-ring plastic beverage holders
  - Copper and appliance cords
  - Eyeglasses
- The Swap Shop is still closed and will re-open in April.
